I greet you in the wonderful name of Jesus. I hope that this finds you enjoying his peace as you serve in His time! The following is a brief report of what God has done, and continues to do at the ministry of Lighthouse Outreaches, East Africa Region.



"Beyond Limit" - Our Own Missions Team

Missions Outreach: "Beyond Limit", this name given to our vigilant team of missionaries drawn from different churches around the country. Three times every year, "Beyond Limit" does missions outreach and helps promote church planting in different parts of the country. For the past two years, we have seen souls come to the Lord in hundreds in our missions' trips among the Pokot of Northern Frontier district of Kenya, the Maasai of Rift Valley, the Kisii of North Rift and among the Digo people of South Coast at the border of Kenya and Tanzania. Pray for this team, they are people of modest means; raise their own funds for every mission's trip which costs about US\$50 per person. A lot of money considering most of the people around here earns about three dollars a day. You can sponsor a missionary or two at US\$50 for every mission trip. We are also praying for a mission tour van which will cost us about US\$20,000. If you know someone who has a 'give away' van or the money, get in touch with us "pronto".



MTSC (Missions to South Coast): We have come a long way and one of the hall marks of our ministry is work among the Digo People of East Africa the southern part of the coastline along the border of Kenya Tanzania. Working among the Digo who are predominantly Muslims has been both challenging as well as fulfilling. We started with three churches in the region whose Sunday service membership for the three churches combined would often enough be less than 50 members. For over 15 years now, the number of churches and we have over twenty churches associated with our ministry, with a combined membership of about 1000 members. We have established a church Planting & Missions training program in the region and this year we will be graduating 30 church planters. They later become initiators of church planting activities in their respective villages and thereby contribute to the global church planting movement, albeit, in a small way. It costs US\$ 200 (Two Hundred) to train one church planter per year. Similar training programs exist in other towns such as Nakuru, Nairobi, Narok, and Loikotok and soon to be established among the Burji of Northern Ethiopia. LIGHTHOUSE TRAINING AND RETREAT CENTER: Pray for God's resources that we may be able to complete the construction of our Training and Retreat center in Limuru. Its completion will see us save US\$500 every month which is goes towards paying rent in our current location. Being in our own place will also help us to expand as a ministry, because those, whom we cannot reach in their own locations, can come and access residential training at the center in Limuru. This would expand our outreach to even church leaders in other countries in the East Africa Diaspora.

PARTNERSHIP: We would be eager to have people partner with us particularly by sending regular teams on short mission trips of between 1-2 weeks. We would also be happy to have volunteer missionaries who would like to come and work with us for a while or even on long term basis.

PRAYER POINTS: In order to successfully run this ministry, we require at least US\$1,500 every month. This caters for rent, staff allowances, communication, transportation and other utilities such as internet services, electricity and water needs. Presently, we have no regular source of income and we pray that God will touch some one out there, either individuals or organizations, who can commit to help us meet the monthly budget in
