

DON WALKER BARRETT, JR., age 59, of Little Rock, died Sunday, March 28, 1999. Born in Little Rock, he was a Group Leader for the InfoBase Product Group at Acxiom Corporation in Conway. He was also a charter member of the First United Methodist Church of Maumelle and served on the Board of Trustees. Don was a much loved and respected executive at Acxiom for over 15 years. He started his professional career as a mathematician at NASA for five years after graduating from Arkansas State Teachers College (now UCA). He moved on to IBM in a sales capacity where he worked for 18 years in a variety of locations in management positions before joining Acxiom.
