

DR. LAWRENCE WILLIAM PERRY, JR., of 5111 Arlington Drive, North Little Rock, chief of the dental service of Arkansas Children's Hospital, died Friday, January 17, 1986.

Perry was a past president of the Arkansas Dental Association, past president of the Pulaski County Dental Society and was a member of the advisory board of the Pulaski Vocational Technical Dental Assistant School.

He was a graduate of Little Rock Central High School, Hendrix College in Conway, and the University of Tennessee School of Dentistry.

In 1984, Perry made an unsuccessful bid for Position #6 on the North Little Rock School Board.

He was a member of Amboy United Methodist Church and the Kiwanis Club and served as adviser for the Key Stone Club of the North Little Rock Boys Club.
