WASHINGTON, D.C. - Suddenly, on May 6, 2008, at Georgetown University Hospital, James Clark Wood Jr., of Washington, D.C. The son of the late James C. Wood, Sr. and Frances Kirten Wood, he was born April 12, 1939 in England, Arkansas and grew up in Little Rock. Mr. Wood attended the University of the South (Sewanee) and received his undergraduate and law degrees from the University of Arkansas. His son Ashley Wood died in 1996.
