

**Paul W. Davis**, 33, of 410 North Palm Street was found dead at his home about 1 p.m. Sunday, November 19, 1972 by his parents.

Police said Davis' parents, Mr. & Mrs. Paul G. Davis, returned home from church and found their son lying next to his bed with a gunshot wound in the head and a .32 caliber pistol lying nearby.

The Pulaski County coroner has not issued a ruling on the death.

Davis was an employee of Rye Auto Parts of North Little Rock and a member of Christ Episcopal Church.

Others surviving are a daughter, Deborah Lynn Davis of North Little Rock; two brothers, Robert S. Davis of North Little Rock and James T. Davis of Little Rock; his grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. J.A. Thompson of Miami, Florida, and Mrs. Birdie Davis of Little Rock.

Funeral was today at Christ Episcopal Church by Rev. Rufus J. Womble, burial was in Pinecrest Memorial Park by Griffin-Leggett.
